


# Michelin User Guide



## Digital Single Barrel Footpump



Thank you for purchasing the Michelin Digital Single Barrel Footpump.

 Please read the operating instructions carefully before using your footpump. Improper use can cause damage to property and possibly harm the user. When using the footpump ensure the vehicle is parked in a safe location, off the road with the vehicle handbrake on and where your personal safety is not at risk.

 **WARNING!**

- Never allow children to use this footpump.
- Never over inflate.
- Always use in a safe area away from traffic and other dangers.

 **WARNING! ENSURE CORRECT TYRE PRESSURES**

- Correct tyre pressure is vital for road safety.
- Under or over inflated tyres can be dangerous.
- Always ensure that regular weekly checks are carried out to the vehicle manufacturer's recommended pressures including the spare, but excluding space saver tyres. Check always before a long journey or after loading or unloading vehicle.
- Always check pressures in an ambient temperature, never immediately after a long journey.

**CAUTION**

- Inspect before each use.
- Do not kink or block the air hose when working.
- Do not use the footpump if bent, broken, melted, or any of the components are damaged.
- Only use the adaptors supplied with the device.

## DIGITAL SINGLE BARREL FOOTPUMP

### OPERATING FEATURES



1. PSI, BAR & KPa button / Reset button
2. White L.C.D digital display
3. Ergonomic rubber tread plate
4. Rubber feet
5. Locking lever
6. 67cm (approx) high pressure air hose with tyre valve connector
7. Adaptors (snap-in storage under display unit)

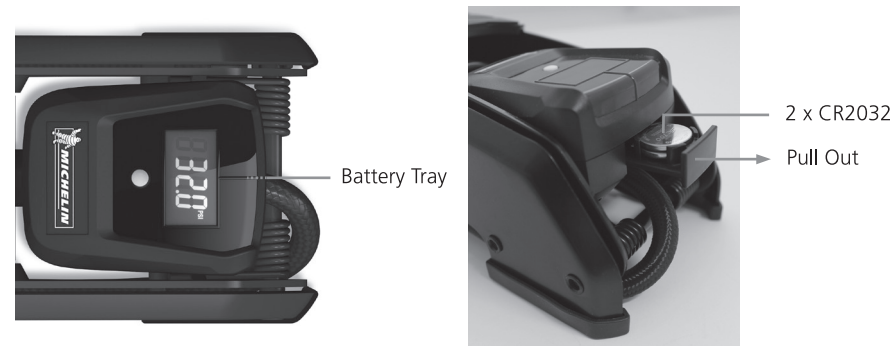
**THIS DIGITAL FOOT PUMP IS FITTED WITH A BATTERY OPERATED DIGITAL GAUGE**

**TO OPERATE**

1. Press the yellow button (1) to turn on the display. Wait a few seconds until the display shows zero.
2. To choose a pressure format, PSI, BAR or kPa press the yellow button (1). Each press of the button cycles through the pressure format.
3. To save battery power the gauge will automatically turn off after approximately 30 seconds if not in use.
4. Uncoil the high pressure hose (6) & screw tyre valve connector (6) to the tyre valve. When connected correctly the gauge will display the current pressure in the tyre. If this is the tyre pressure as stated in your vehicle's handbook you can simply remove the tyre valve connector (7).
5. To unlock the foot plate slightly depress the foot plate & twist down the yellow lock levers (5) & slowly let the foot plate extend. To inflate push slowly & firmly on the foot plate until the desired pressure is shown on the digital display.
6. Remove the tyre valve connector (6) from the tyre valve. Take care when unscrewing the tyre valve connector.
7. To lock the foot plate in the closed position slowly push the foot plate down & twist up the yellow lock levers (5).
8. Special adaptors (7) are provided to inflate sports balls, air beds, small inflatables etc. To avoid over-inflation, always follow manufacturer's instructions on the items to be inflated.

**TO REPLACE THE BATTERIES**

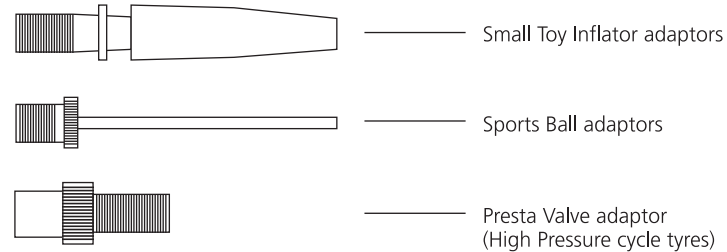
The display will show "LO" when the batteries need replacing, to do this:



1. Pull out battery tray (as above) & remove old batteries.
2. Note that polarity for both is positive "+" upwards & replace with new CR2032 or equivalent.
3. Push back the battery tray, if correctly inserted display will illuminate to confirm this.

**ADAPTORS**

Included with your Michelin Digital Single Barrel Footpump, on the back of the display unit, is a snap-in storage compartment containing various adaptors, to enable you to inflate other items. To avoid over-inflation, always follow manufacturer's instructions on the items to be inflated.



**TROUBLE SHOOTING**

<b>Gauge does not illuminate</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Check batteries are correctly inserted into tray.</li> <li>■ Batteries flat - Replace with 2 x CR2032 or equivalent.</li> </ul>
<b>Display fails to switch on when yellow button is pressed</b>	
<b>Display shows 'LO'</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Replace batteries (2 x CR2032 or equivalent).</li> </ul>
<b>Gauge appears to read incorrectly or is unreadable</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ When the tyre valve connector is attached, before switching the unit on, ensure the gauge is reading your current tyre pressure.</li> <li>■ Disconnect from tyre for at least 5 seconds, or until display goes off.</li> <li>■ Press yellow reset button until display shows all the digits then returns to 0.0.</li> </ul>
<b>Pumping but tyre is not inflating</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Check that the tyre valve adaptor is correctly fitted to tyre valve.</li> </ul>
<b>Gauge does not display when tyre valve is connected</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Ensure tyre valve is correctly connected to the tyre valve adaptor.</li> </ul>
